HIGHPOINT END OF SERIES QUALIFICATIONS & SUPER HORSE QUALIFICATIONS

Be sure to participate in all classes specified in divisions to qualify.

- > Standard Highpoint for entire series must participate in 2 of the 3 shows and participate in all required classes for that division. (If you only show one class and it requires two, you will get zero points) SUPER HORSE REQUIRES ALL 3 SHOWS ATTENDANCE WITH REQUIRED CLASSES.
- Each show will have a standard high point champion and reserve for all riding divisions, over all halter, showmanship, and trail. *super horse is end of series
- > Jr Classes are 17 and under. Amateur is 18 and older (no professionals) and Open is open to all including professionals.
- Standard/Superhorse Highpoint division must be selected upon first entry. Divisions are Walk/Jog or Walk/Jog/Lope.
- Buckles will be Standard Highpoint champion prizes for all riding divisions and overall halter that qualify. Showmanship and reserves will be other prizes.
- Superhorse prizes will be surprises! Super Horse horse/rider combinations just choose discipline, division, AND gait division on the entry form at the first show you compete in.

WE WILL HAVE SUPERHORSE category as well!

- If you do super horse, you must pick one gait, Division and Discipline to qualify.
 - Western Pleasure/WJ
 - Western Pleasure/WJL
 - Ranch/WJ
 - Ranch/WJL
- You must participate in Showmanship, Halter, the division riding classes and trail. Classes must correspond to the Discipline and Gait. Ex. Ranch/WJ
- You must participate in all 3 shows.
- Horse/rider combination with highest points accumulated will win at end of series.
- Tie breaker will remain the pattern riding class.

Must participate in:

- ➤ Halter (class 4-7) *8 (Champion and Reserve will be bonus on total. Champion 2 added points and Reserve 1 added point for end of series.
- Showmanship- Choose same Division you are riding in
- Pleasure/horsemanship riding classes-Same Division you are in showmanship in. Must do same qualifying classes as standard division.
- > Trail-Same gait you are riding in

Ties in riding classes will be broken by the points of the pattern class.

Ties in Halter will be broken by grand and reserve champion points. Grand will receive 2 points/ reserve will receive 1 point.
